century after marx the great hopes of socialism to achieve successful and productive nationalization of industries on the basis of a national economic plan had been recognized as unproductive and undesirable part iii reviews the failed attempt to establish a viable socialist party in the united states the real thrust toward socialism originally launched by the new deal of roosevelt came when barak obama a thoroughly indoctrinated and dedicated socialist ascended to the us presidency this socialism is an attempt to expand income redistribution and social welfare policies and to pursue massive industrial regulation and unconstitutional interventions in the private sector the implications of these policies are discussed together with the associated loss of market freedoms and personal liberties
